## **What is the event?**

Join Volunteer San Diego's SAVY (Students Actively Volunteering for You) Leaders at Mission Trails Park on April 21<sup>st</sup> for a 5K Walk in honor of National and Global Youth Service Day. ## **Who are SAVY Leaders and Volunteer San Diego?**

The SAVY (Students Actively Volunteering for You) Leaders are Volunteer San Diego's youth leadership council. These forty high school students meet regularly to plan National Days of Service and promote youth volunteerism throughout the year.

## **What is NGYSD?**
